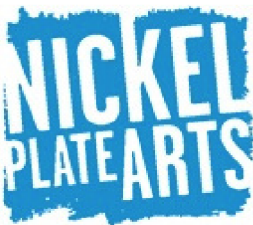

The season concludes with 1981 American Pianists Awards winner Sara Davis Buechner's autobiographical theater show, "Of Pigs and Pianos," which details her journey through music and life as a transgender woman coming of age in New York City at the end of the 20th century.

*The New York Times* describes the show as "offering fine performances of nine varied and challenging works that poignantly defined moments in the journey of a courageous artist...Buechner's story, though often wrenching, was rich with childhood fantasies, wistful longings and absurd turns that had the audience laughing along."
