



Suzuki Steps – 2021-2022

Start your Suzuki journey with your child with our Suzuki Early Childhood Education (SECE) Classes on Saturdays for newborns to 3 or 4 years old. The goal is to provide a nurturing environment from birth that stimulates the rich partnerships that develop between parent, child and teacher. Using traditional nursery rhymes, action songs, lullabies and instruments, this class seeks to build on the child's natural delight in learning and lay the foundation for musical skills such as beat, rhythm, pitch and tone.

Babies and parents together will:

- Learn a sense of pitch
- Listen for ringing tones
- Be exposed to rhythms and beats
- Build confidence, character, independence
- Learn the key principles of the Suzuki Method

COVID SECE Information

The Indianapolis Suzuki Academy is committed to supporting the health and well-being of our students, families and faculty during the COVID pandemic. To that end, we have carefully set up the following procedures in accordance with CDC and Public Health guidelines for schools and community gatherings.

- New classroom space has been secured on the 2nd floor of our studios, offering roughly 1,600 square feet of open concept space for SECE classes.
- In-Person Class sizes will be limited to no more than 8 students to accommodate social distancing.
- Masks are required to be worn by anyone over the age of 2 years old.
- Items or instruments will not be shared during class, but rather, teachers will establish a rotation in which children take turns week after week being able to try different instruments. Proper cleaning will occur in between classes.
- We will continue to monitor the current public health guidance, and update procedures and communication as necessary.
