COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

By enrolling in Suzuki Steps, families agree to the following procedures and responsibilities.

Monitoring Health

Our family will monitor our health on a regular basis and take reasonable precautions to minimize exposure to COVID-19 infection.

Our family will self-monitor on a daily basis for symptoms of possible illness or COVID-19 infection (e.g., cough, sore throat, fever, chills, muscle pain, loss of smell or taste, and/or shortness of breath)

Stay at Home / Be Sent Home

I understand I may need to Stay at Home or be Sent Home due to COVID-19 if any of the following are true:

- A member of our family has been exposed and/or has reason to believe we have been exposed to COVID-19
- A member of our family has a fever (temperature of 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit or greater)
- A member of our family is exhibiting other symptoms consistent with COVID-19 infection (e.g., cough, sore throat, fever, chills, muscle pain, loss of sense of smell or taste, and/or shortness of breath), or
- A member of our family has been advised by a healthcare professional to self isolate due to actual or possible COVID-19 infection or exposure

Follow the ISA Studio Policies

While at ISA studios or events, members of our family will:

- Practice good personal hygiene (wash hands frequently with soap and water, or use a hand sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol if soap is unavailable)
- Hallway Rule - Do not wait in the hallway. If another family is temporarily in the hallway, please wait your turn to pass.
- Mask wearing - masks must be worn by any person at ISA over the age of 2 years.
- One Way Traffic - please follow the one way traffic pattern - in the east door, out the west door.
- Siblings - family members present at ISA studios will need to stay together in the class, and no family members may wait in public areas.
- Wear a cloth face covering (consistent with CDC guidelines)

- Items such as the xylophone will only be used by one participant per class.
- Social distancing between households will be maintained during class

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
